ONE- Metro Region - San Juan & Surrounds


San Juan is the island's vibrant heart, blending 500+ years of history with contemporary culture.

BEST TIME TO TRAVEL

- · Low Season (Jul-Oct): Hot and humid, tropical storm risk; best for deals
