Travel Tips from Suzi @ Nothing Ventured

- **Location, Location:** Your hotel is perfectly positioned between Bingin and Padang Padang. It's one of the few spots where you are close to the trendy cafes while still having that cliffside sanctuary feel.
- **Scooter vs. Driver:** Uluwatu's best spots are tucked down narrow lanes. The Radisson offers great shuttle services, but for total freedom, download the **Grab app** to get around. If it rains, the limestone steps to the beaches can get slippery, so take your time.
- **The February Advantage: This is the "quiet" season.** You'll find the best tables at world-famous restaurants are much easier to book, and the beaches are far less crowded.
- **The Rain Strategy:** February can bring tropical showers, usually in the mid-afternoon. We've planned your "big views" for the mornings and kept your late afternoons flexible for spa time or long, indoor lunches.



Day 1: Coastal Caves & Candlelit Evenings

- **Morning: The Cave & The Cove**
 - **9:00 AM:** Head to Suluban Beach. Explore the dramatic cave opening that leads out to the surf break. It feels like a movie set and is incredibly romantic in the soft morning light.
- **Lunch: A Cliffside Perch**
 - Walk up to **Single Fin** for a casual lunch. It's undercover, so if a February shower passes through, you have the best seat in the house to watch the storm roll over the Indian Ocean.
- **Afternoon: Rejuvenation at the Blu**
 - Head back to the **Radisson Blu** for a couple's massage at the **Escenza Spa**. February is the perfect time to lean into the "wellness" side of Bali while the rain feeds the lush gardens outside.
- **Evening: Culture & Fire**
 - **5:15 PM:** Visit **Uluwatu Temple** for the **Kecak Fire Dance**. The performance continues rain or shine, there is something incredibly powerful about watching the fire dance against a moody, tropical sky.
 - **Dinner:** Enjoy a refined Italian dinner at **Filini** (located right at your hotel). Their outdoor terrace is stunning, but they have a beautiful indoor space if the evening breeze picks up.



Day 2: Turquoise Waters & Glass-Bottom Views

- **Morning: The Most Iconic Drive in Bali**
 - **9:30 AM:** Head to **Melasti Beach**. The road carved through towering white limestone cliffs is a must-see. In February, the surrounding greenery is at its most vibrant green.
- **Lunch: Luxury Beach Clubbing**
 - Spend your afternoon at **Tropical Temptation** or **Sundays Beach Club**. These clubs have excellent covered lounge areas and "all-weather" vibes, allowing you to enjoy the beach lifestyle regardless of the forecast.
- **Afternoon: Handcrafted Mementos**
 - Take a short trip to a **Silver Jewelry Class** in the Pecatu area. Spend a few hours together designing and hammering your own silver rings, a perfect indoor activity and a permanent memory of your trip.
- **Evening: The Grand Finale**
 - **5:30 PM:** Experience **Oneeighty° at The Edge**. Their glass-bottom pool hanging over the cliff is world-famous. If it's a clear evening, the sunset here is unbeatable.
 - **Final Dinner:** Finish your 48 hours at **El Kabron Spanish Restaurant**. Their "Sedue" sunset sessions and incredible seafood paella are the most glamorous way to toast to your Bali adventure.
